To address the critical situation of health requirements and to provide basic medical facilities to people in need at remote rural areas and urban slums, HPCL CSR partnering with ground level NGOs are running Mobile Medical Vans. These vans provide basic medical attention to total populace in 75 villages. Through this partnership HPCL has ensured medical facilities at the doorsteps of villagers providing basic treatments for common ailments, health awareness and make necessary referrals for major ailments.

# **OBJECTIVES:**

 Main project objective is to provide awareness, diagnostic and curative services through Mobile Medical Units to the rural community

### **KEY STRATEGIES:**

- MMV runs on all working days
- Roster for MMV
- At least two points of operations in each village
- One doctor and one pharmacist for the MMV

- villages are getting health care services.
- Underprivileged people availing the services of MMV/day.
- Health care services at door step.

#### IMPACTS:

- Easy accessibility of health care services at door step.
- Free of cost health care services.
- MMV has reduced expenses on medicines.
- Addressed the health care needs of the targeted villages
